



R for Economists - An Introductory Workshop

What?

A three-day workshop, offered by the Department of Economics at UNC, designed to introduce undergraduate economics students to the programming language R — which is frequently used for data analysis in economics.

When and where?

The workshop will take place on July 27th, 28th, and 29th, from 1pm to 5pm. It will be offered virtually on Zoom. Note that this is a synchronous workshop. Students who register for the workshop need to be available during these times.

Who?

All undergraduate economics students are welcome to register for this workshop. Note that this is an introductory workshop, designed for students who have little or no experience using the statistical computing language/environment R.

How much does it cost?

Thanks to the generosity of donors to the department, the Department of Economics at UNC will subsidize the registration cost of this workshop down to \$50 per attendee. In addition, this registration cost will be waived for students who attend the entirety of the workshop. This means that you can sign up and attend the whole workshop without paying anything. If you sign up for the workshop but do not attend, you will be asked to write a \$50 check to the Department of Economics.
