Overview

Students will make trades within their paper accounts and gain exposure to the same user interface and features utilized by live accounts at Interactive Brokers.

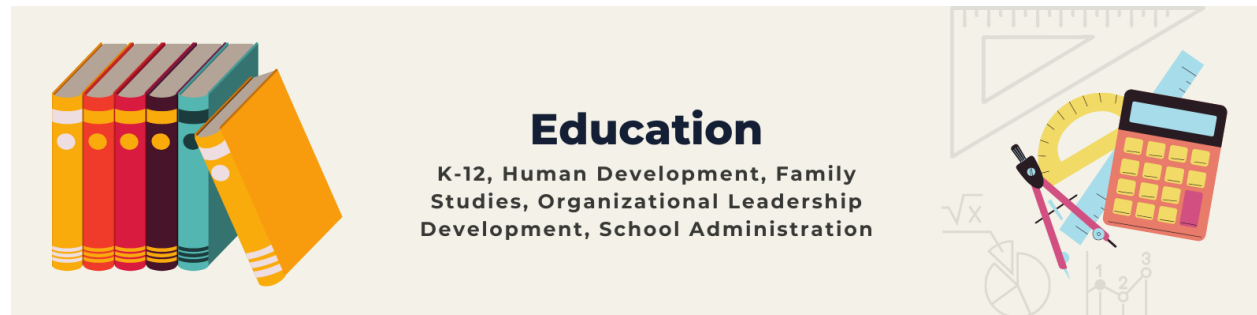
